How Does Lifeline Work?

1. Call for Help

When you need help, press your Personal Help Button, which activates the Lifeline home unit. This unit dials the local Lifeline Monitoring Center and establishes two-way voice communication.

2. Lifeline Answers

Within seconds a local Lifeline Personal Response Associate with instant access to your personal profile communicates with you. They will find out what you need and assess the situation.

3. Lifeline Responds

The Personal Response Associate then contacts a neighbor, loved one or emergency services to come to your assistance. They also follow up to ensure that help arrived.





Who Responds When I Press My Help Button?

A caring and specially trained Personal Response Associate has instant access to your personal profile. Your call will be answered locally, not by a call center in another state.

Why Do I Need Lifeline?

Life can be unpredictable. An unexpected fall or medical emergency could threaten your health if help is delayed. But with Lifeline, help is assured. And it is not only for medical emergencies. This service also gives peace of mind and a stronger sense of well-being.

You can maintain your independent lifestyle with confidence. Lifeline subscribers are ten times less likely to be placed in a long-term care facility and they had a 26% decrease in hospital admissions. With Lifeline you can continue to live confidently in the comfort of home.
